ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants are advised to read and understand all the instructions and guidelines contained on these pages. Failure to follow them could result in the application being rejected.

A TOTAL OF FIVE (5) SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE

THE VALUE OF EACH SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE \$500.

The Scholarships are available to support one graduating student from each of the five High Schools in West Vancouver who is enrolled in, pre-registered at and accepted by a recognised Post-Secondary Institution in a Professional, Technological, Trade or other approved programme that will start no later than one academic year following graduation.

PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP:

The Scholarships will be awarded to the successful candidates at a School Ceremony. However, it is expected that the winners will attend a meeting of the West Vancouver Branch of the Royal Canadian Legion for recognition purposes.

THE RECIPIENT MUST BE A GRADUATING STUDENT FROM ANY OF:

- West Vancouver, Sentinel, or Rockridge Secondary Schools,
- Collingwood (Morven) or Mulgrave Schools.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Academic Achievement
- Extra- Curricular involvement (priority given to Remembrance Day support or Veteran Association)
- Involvement in the Greater Community
- Related or other Work Experience
- Citizenship
- Other criteria as chosen by the school.

SELECTION PROCESS:
